

# LAGRANGE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD MINUTES

February 16, 2023 7:00 PM Maple Wood Nature Center

**MINUTES:** Paul Yoder moved and Paul Baker seconded a motion to approve the minutes from the January 26, 2023 meeting. Motion carried.

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

A. Delt Pavilion Project

Shetler Construction is still on schedule. The pavilion is almost done and restrooms are being started.

- B. Mike Metz Fen LWCF Project
  - Pavilion supplies have been received. Romtec materials are on the way. The maintenance staff will begin installation after Maple Syrup Days.
- C. Master plan
  - Mary sent draft to DNR for review. May be a month before a response is received.
- D. Alarm System
  - The system was ordered from Tech Solutions, who is contracted for the county service plan. Installation is delayed while waiting for electronic parts.
- E. Maple Syrup Days
  - So far, 4825 gallons of sap has been collected, 63.25 gallons of syrup made. Syrup have been golden and amber finishes. New this year, 50 taps have been connected to a hose/pump system. This system has yielded 30% more syrup than typical drip.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

A. Soarin hawk raptors

Leslie Arnold is working on the possibility of housing a screech owl for public programs. Will work on budget needed for food, vet bills, & housing needs. Earliest would be spring 2024.

B. Fun time kayak rentals

Mary Franke presented an idea for provided another recreational activity to the public. A kayak vending machine – self operating with QR code, credit card, charged from time kayak removed and returned. Can set rental charge. Start up cost is \$3500/kayak, minimum of 4 kayaks for total of \$14,500 start up costs. Covers 5 years service. Profits are split 50-50. Kayak company carries all liability and insurance, provides installation, and all repairs/replacements. Questions included: power source need? Where to install? Concrete pad install/cost? Board discussed. No decision made at this time.

A. Board and Director discussed procedures of purchasing property in the future.
