### **County Request for Proposals for Annual Gasoline/Diesel Fuel Needs**

January 2024 - December 2024.

#### **RFP Process**

The Board of Commissioners of the County of LaGrange ("Board") on behalf of LaGrange County, Indiana ("County") hereby make this request for proposals ("RFP") for the supply of gasoline and diesel fuel sufficient to meet all daily fuel needs of County-owned vehicles during the year 2022 ("Fuel Requisition"). Sealed proposals will be opened at the Board of Commissioners meeting room on Monday, October 16, 2023 local time or shortly thereafter at the County Office Building and either read aloud or made available for viewing to those interested.

The Board will award the proposal to the Offeror whose responsible and responsive offer is deemed most advantageous to the County. Conformance with the RFP is the most important factor in the award, then price, then convenience. The Board reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, to waive technicalities or irregularities therein, and to delete any proposal item. No proposal shall be withdrawn after the opening of proposals without the consent of the Board for a period of sixty (60) days after the scheduled time for receiving the same. The Board may discuss sufficiently conforming proposals with their respective Offerors after the opening.

### **RFP Specifications**

The County desires lowest price-per-gallon proposals for the following items.

- 1. **Gasoline** around 56,000 gallons of unleaded gasoline with a minimum octane rating of 87, Top-Tier gasoline is requested, spread out evenly throughout the year as needed by County-owned vehicles, we request that the fuel provided comes from one single source/brand.
- 2. **Diesel** around 85,000 gallons of #2 Premium Ultra low sulfur diesel fuel, spread out evenly throughout the year as needed by County-owned vehicles. The diesel fuel shall have: minimum cetane 50; total sulfur content less than 15 ppm; flash point minimum 125° F; Cloud point 5° F; specifications must meet or exceed ASTM D975 Diesel Fuel Oil Specifications; and product must meet Cummins L10 injector deposit testing specifications for detergents.

Each proposal shall take the following considerations into account.

- 1. Price-per-gallon quotes should not include tax. The County is tax exempt and will furnish a tax-exempt certificate upon request.
- 2. Fluctuating prices should be based upon the price of fuel on October 1, 2023.
- 3. Fuel must be available to all County-owned vehicles at all locations within the County, the departments included for LaGrange County are as follows, Highway, Sheriff, Surveyor, Parks, Prosecutor, Soil & Water, Building, Planning/Zoning, Health.

- 4. Purchase at each location must accept as part of its payment methods a card identifying the user and/or identifying the vehicle into which fuel is dispensed.
- 5. The selected Offeror shall provide a monthly report of purchases throughout the year. Such reports will indicate the following: the date and time of sale; the fuel type; the vehicle's current mileage; and the name of the cardholder making each purchase.
- 6. Failure to abide by these provisions shall be grounds for rescission of the award and/or contract at any time throughout the 2024 calendar year.
- 7. A sample proposal form has been attached to this RFP as Exhibit A.

#### **Proposal Requirements**

Each proposal for the Fuel Requisition shall comply with all the following requirements.

- 1. Each proposal shall be submitted in a sealed envelope at the office of the LaGrange County Auditor, County Office Building, 114 W. Michigan St., LaGrange, IN. 46761, until 9:00 a.m. local time on Monday, October 16, 2023.
- 2. Each sealed envelope must clearly indicate the name, address, and telephone number of the offeror and be marked "2024 Fuel Requisition."
- 3. Each proposal shall include a completed Proposal Form, as found in Exhibit A.
- 4. Each proposal shall include a completed and notarized Affidavit, as found in Exhibit B.
- 5. All documents used in the proposal shall be submitted in duplicate.

[Proposal-Specific Requirements]

- 6. Each proposal shall specify the octane rating of the proposed gasoline supply and the information about the proposed diesel fuel supply.
- 7. Each proposal shall specify the terminal source and brand of fuel for the fuel supply.
- 8. Each proposal shall describe winter diesel fuel target cold flow, CFPP and Pour Point numbers, and procedures and pricing for winter blending of diesel fuel.
- 9. Each proposal shall explain its methodology for establishing its firm price.
- 10. Each proposal shall designate all complying fuel purchase locations within the County.
- 11. Each proposal shall list and explain any required contract terms.
