## Shipshewana Lake Park

3180 N 915 W Shipshewana

Quiet lake-side park with small playground, and picnic areas.  
Great for sunset views over the lake!

Park is 3/4 mile from Pumpkinvine Trail.



## Trails open daily --- walk, run, hike, roll

Trail surfaces are boardwalk and/or crushed limestone meeting accessibility standards\*. Bring yourself and your wagons, strollers, wheelchairs, and enjoy each park.

Bicycles on trails is prohibited except at Delt Church Park and Duff Memorial Park.

## Dallas Lake Park w/Pond Lil

505 W 700 S Wolcottville 141 acres

South shore of Dallas Lake.  
Wetland observation deck for wildlife watching.  
Nearly 2 mile loop accessible walking trail with fitness stations.  
Primitive half mile prairie trail is natural surface.  
Beach, playground, picnic areas, grass playing field.  
Lodge and pavilion are available for rental.  
Beach Admission \$1.00 per person/day or \$40 for family pass.



## David Rogers Memorial Park

2355 W 550 S Wolcottville 15 acres


Six relocated pioneer log buildings and grave with memorial to pioneer philanthropist and naturalist, Dr. David Rogers.  
1800's log barn is popular to rent for rustic weddings.  
A practice pickleball court is on west end.



## Delt Church Park

6455 S 200 W Wolcottville 110 acres

Next to the North Branch of Elkhart River.  
Three pavilions are available for rental.



The Mega Tower accessible playground for ages 2-5 & 5-12.

18-Hole Disc Golf Course, 2 mile loop accessible multi-purpose trail, restored prairie, grass playing field.



## Maple Wood Nature Center

4550 E 100 S LaGrange 132 acres

Northern hardwood forest, wooded swamp, and wet prairie.

Enjoy 2 miles of loop trails among wildflowers, birds, and nearly 40 species of trees. Spring wildflowers and autumn foliage are peak times to visit. Mindfulness activity stations.

Maple Syrup Days festival is the 3rd full weekend of March.

Maple Wood Nature Center is perfect for public and school nature programs.

Nature Center is available for rental year-round,  
EXCEPT February and March.



## Pine Knob Park w/Mike Metz Fen

2825 E SR 120 Howe 275 acres

Savanna, fen, marsh, woodland, and Meteer and Duff Lakes.  
Archery targets and a wooded 3-D archery trail with life-sized game targets (use field points only). 3-D Archery Trail \$5 fee.

Nearly 4 miles of accessible loop trails - outer loop of orange and blue trails is 3.5 miles; plus, another .75 mile rustic trail.  
Two fishing docks, three picnic pavilions, Clubhouse available to rent for daily occasions.



## Duff Memorial Park

6225 N 300 E Howe 24 acres

Mountain Bicycle Trail 1.7 miles

Views from the SW shore of Cedar Lake.
