INVESTMENT POLICY OF PUBLIC FUNDS ORDINANCE

Mr. George Bachman presented the following ordinance for consideration:

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING LAGRANGE COUNTY TO ADOPT A NEW INVESTMENT POLICY OF PUBLIC FUNDS PURSUANT TO IND. CODE § 5-13-9-5.7

ORDINANCE NO: 2015 -12-14

WHEREAS, the County of LaGrange seeks to adopt an investment policy to assist the Treasurer of the County of LaGrange, the investment officer, with the investment of public funds;

WHEREAS, in 2012, the Indiana General Assembly amended Indiana Code § 5-13-9-5.7 to allow political subdivisions, including counties, to invest public funds for more than two (2) years and not more than five (5) years;

WHEREAS, the County Council seeks to adopt an investment policy authorizing the investment officer to make investment of public funds, as prescribed in Ind. Code § 5-13-9-5.7, for a period of more than two (2) years and not more than five (5) years;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF LAGRANGE, INDIANA, THAT:

REGULAR SESSION

The LaGrange County Council hereby adopts the LaGrange County investment policy, pursuant to Ind. Code § 5-13-9-5.7, authorizing the following:

- A. the investment of public funds for more than two (2) years but not more than five (5) years;
- B. the investment officer to make investments having a stated maturity that is more than two (2) years but not more than five (5) years after the date of purchase or entry into a repurchase agreement;
- C. the investment officer to contract with a federally regulated investment advisor or other institutional money manager to make investments under this Ordinance.

Further, that the LaGrange County Council hereby adopts the LaGrange County investment policy which limits the investment of the County's public funds that have a stated final maturity of more than two (2) years and not more than five (5) years to not more than twenty-five percent (25%) of the total portfolio of the County's public funds invested by the investment officer, including balances in transaction accounts.

Further, the LaGrange County Council hereby adopts the LaGrange County investment policy for a period not to exceed more than four (4) years after its adoption hereof, at which time it shall expire.
