APRIL 9, 2018

REGULAR SESSION

The LaGrange County Council met in Regular Session on Monday, April 9, 2018, at their meeting room, County Office Building, 114 W. Michigan Street, LaGrange, Indiana 46761, at 8:30 a.m., with the following present: Council Members, Charles F. Ashcraft, George R. Bachman, Jeffrey L. Brill, Peter A. Cook, Harold D. Gingerich, Steven E. McKowen and Michael G. Strawser; and LaGrange County Auditor, Kay M. Myers. Mr. Peter Cook brought the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

PUBLIC DEFENDER BOARD

Mr. Fritz Schlemmer, Public Defender Board Chairman, was present. He explained that the board is in need of clerical help to prepare the quarterly voucher for the State reimbursement. Mr. George Bachman made a motion to proceed with an Independent Contractor Agreement not to exceed \$2,400. Mr. Charles Ashcraft seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

AMENDMENT TO THE SALARY ORDINANCE

Mr. Steve Engleking, Cooperative Extension Director, was present and requested to increase the part time secretary from 21 hours per week to up to 28 hours per week for up to 36 weeks for 2018.

AMENDMENT TO THE SALARY ORDINANCE FOR 2018

COUNTY JUSTICE BUILDING

Ms. Sarah Farlow, Engineer, gave an update on the County Justice Building. Mrs. Kay Myers, County Auditor, wanted clarification on the figure for the building. Mr. George Bachman made a motion that \$3,800,000 is the figure to be using. Mr. Mike Strawser seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

LAGRANGE COUNTY COMMUNITY FOUNDATION

Mrs. Kay Myers, County Auditor, informed the Council that the LaGrange County Community Foundation has \$39,888.00 available to grant in 2018 from the endowment fund. The money can be moved to the endowment portion of the fund, can be left in the fund or a check may be issued for deposit in the Hospital Trust fund. Mr. Harold Gingerich made a motion to have a check issued. Mr. George Bachman seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS GRANT APPLICATION

Mrs. Kay Myers, County Auditor,, presented the TANF grant, which is a regional grant between LaGrange and Steuben counties. There is no cost to LaGrange County for these programs, and that Steuben County will act as the fiscal agent, and that Steuben County will then get reimbursed by the state. The grant is for \$791,437.50 and it is for one year, with the ability to re-apply for the grant every year. Mr. George Bachman made a motion to approve the grant application as presented. Mr. Jeff Brill seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.

There being nothing further to come before the Board at this time, Mr. Mike Strawser made a motion to adjourn and meet on any subsequent day necessary to carry on the business of the Board. Mr. Charles Ashcraft seconded the motion and it carried unanimously.
