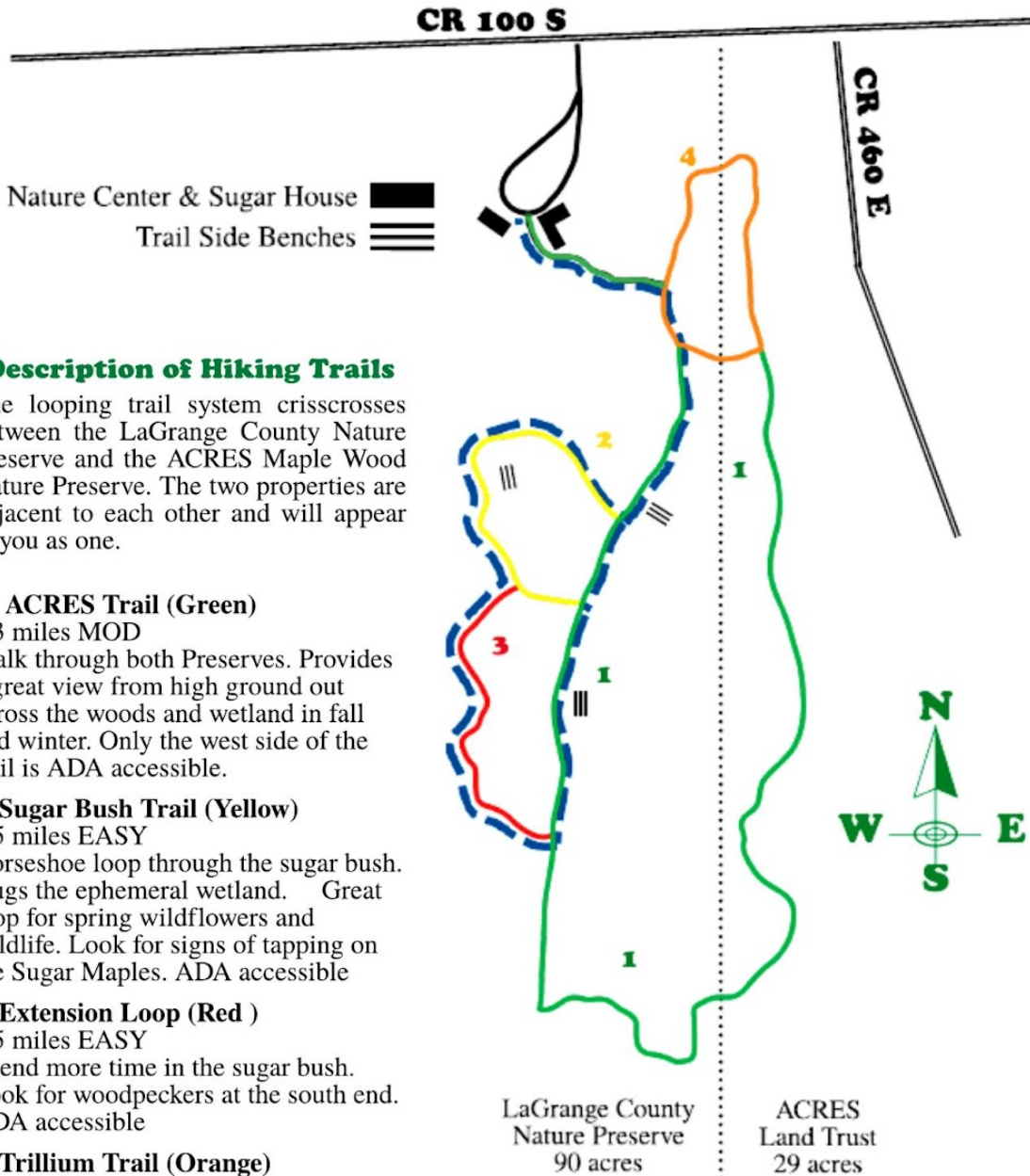


Trail Map

LaGrange County Nature Preserve and Maple Wood Nature Center



Description of Hiking Trails

The looping trail system crisscrosses between the LaGrange County Nature Preserve and the ACRES Maple Wood Nature Preserve. The two properties are adjacent to each other and will appear to you as one.

1. ACRES Trail (Green)

1.3 miles MOD
Walk through both Preserves. Provides a great view from high ground out across the woods and wetland in fall and winter. Only the west side of the trail is ADA accessible.

2. Sugar Bush Trail (Yellow)

.35 miles EASY
Horseshoe loop through the sugar bush. Hugs the ephemeral wetland. Great loop for spring wildflowers and wildlife. Look for signs of tapping on the Sugar Maples. ADA accessible

3. Extension Loop (Red)

.25 miles EASY
Spend more time in the sugar bush. Look for woodpeckers at the south end. ADA accessible

4. Trillium Trail (Orange)

.4 miles EASY
This loop is a dirt and grass path through the woods. Secluded and quiet look at spring wildflowers and rising topography.
